

Note: This is an OPT OUT permission form. You do not need to complete and return this form, unless you do not wish to give permission.

Photographs and Video

We are now using an **opt out** procedure relating to **photographs and video** of students, rather than an **opt in** permission procedure.

- If you **do give your permission** for your student's photo and video to be used as described below, you **do not** need to complete and return this form.
- If you **do not give your permission**, you must check the appropriate boxes below and return this form.

- Do not** allow my child to be photographed/videotaped or interviewed by **news media** or for **public view**.
- Do not** allow my child to be photographed/videotaped or interviewed for **school publications** (yearbook, school webpage, projects).
- Do not** allow my child to be photographed/videotaped or interviewed for **educational purposes**.

Student Use of the Internet

Similarly, we are now using an **opt out** procedure relating to student internet use, rather than an **opt in** permission procedure.

- If you **do give your permission** for your student to use the internet in keeping with established school technology policies and guidelines, you **do not** need to complete and return this form.
- If you **do not give your permission**, you must check the appropriate boxes below and return this form.

- I **do not** give permission for my student to use the internet.
- I **do not** give permission to post my student's work on the school webpage.

Because of the increasingly pervasive use of the internet, if you do not give permission for your student to use the internet, many other technology-related resources will likewise be inaccessible, including: 1) user folder on server for storage; 2) printing; 3) productivity applications (*Word, Excel, PowerPoint*); 4) *CenterPoint*; and 5) various library resources, e.g. catalog, reference and periodical databases. If a student is not permitted to access to these resources because of the internet opt out condition, necessary accommodations for completion of classroom assignments will be made.
